I. MEMBERSHIP

1.1 ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP

INTRODUCTION:

Membership eligibility for boards of social work regulation is established in the Association's Articles of Incorporation and bylaws.

POLICY:

Member Board responsibilities

- 1. Member Boards agree to comply with ASWB bylaws and policies applicable to Member Boards.
 - a. Noncompliance with ASWB bylaws and policies applicable to Member Boards as determined by the ASWB Board of Directors may lead to loss of a Member Board's good standing status.
- 2. Member Boards agree to send a delegate to the Annual Meeting of the Delegate Assembly and any special meetings of the delegate assembly called by the ASWB Board president.
 - a. To be represented by a voting delegate and alternate delegate, Member Boards must be in good standing as determined by the Board of Directors, including but not limited to current in payment of annual dues.
 - i. Dues assessment of a Member Board shall be US\$250 per year.
- 3. Member Boards shall timely comply with reasonable requests from the Association office for data and information related to social work regulation and Member Board operations.

Membership benefits

- 1. Access to all membership benefits is premised on a Member Board's good standing status as determined by the ASWB Board of Directors and includes compliance with ASWB bylaws, policies applicable to Member Boards, and payment of annual dues.
- 2. Benefits include representation at the annual meeting as well as the following services provided by the Association office:
 - Exam / Licensing /Administrative services
 - Information / Research services
 - Publications / Websites
 - Member meetings / Professional development
 - Leadership opportunities
