

## ASWB travel considerations: Attending an ASWB meeting in person

Please read through the following information before making a decision about traveling to an ASWB event.

If you are being funded to attend an ASWB event, be advised that changing or canceling an existing airline or lodging reservation incurs a considerable cost to the association.

The Centers for Disease Control and the World Health Organization recommend that anyone traveling be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and have updated boosters.
